

3G AGP for Saffron Walden – Bank Account – Background Details

- Saffron Walden Community FC (SWCFC) and Saffron Walden County High School (SWCHS) have reached agreement on the siting of a new 3G artificial grass pitch (3G AGP) at the High School. The Essex FA is also supportive of the proposal.
- The football club, along with sister club PSG, has launched a fund raising campaign – known as ‘#mycommunity3G’ - to raise funds locally to support the plan, and will seek planning permission in the coming weeks.
- We hope to have the new 3G AGP facility in place by Spring 2020.
- It will be a high quality 3G AGP facility, meeting FA, UEFA and FIFA standards.
- **SWCFC has also established a new bank account, which will be used solely for fund raising for the 3G AGP pitch.**
- The signatories for the account are:
 - Martin Johnson (SWCFC Chairman);
 - Matt Clare (SW PSG Girls Club Chairman and SWCFC Vice Chairman);
 - Polly Lankester (Associate Head Teacher, SWCHS), and:
 - former Mayor of Saffron Walden Cllr Mike Hibbs.

Vince Taylor (Treasurer of SWCFC) will be added as a fifth signatory in the coming days.

- The bank account is with local institution Saffron Building Society.
- Saffron Building Society are known for supporting local projects and we are delighted to be opening this account with them.
- All monies raised for the 3G campaign will be deposited in this account, and regular progress updates will be made on the level of funds raised.
- Withdrawals will only be made to support development of the 3G scheme.
- In the event that the scheme were not to go ahead for any reason, the monies would revert to SWCFC and SWCHS, to be used in manner consistent with the aims of those organisations.
